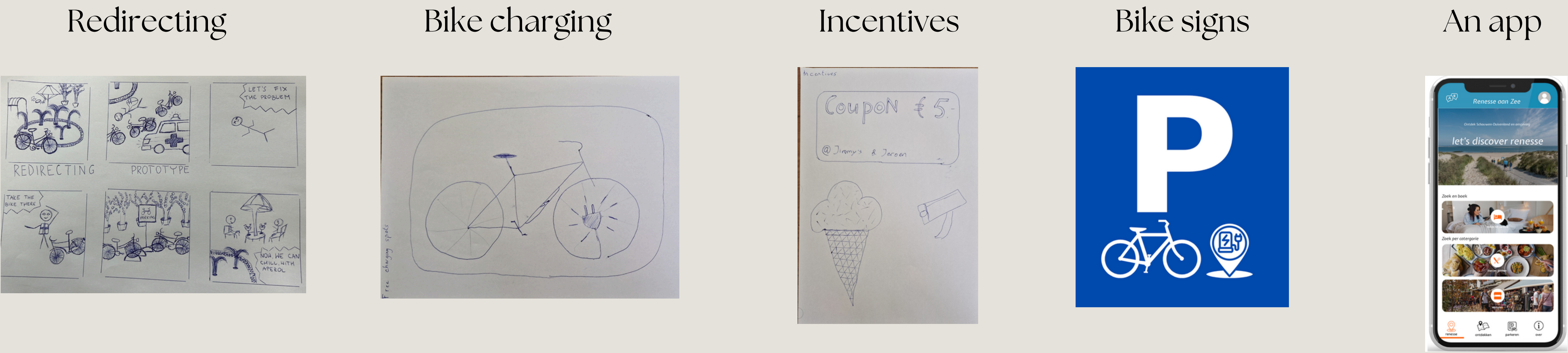

The Client and the Challenge:

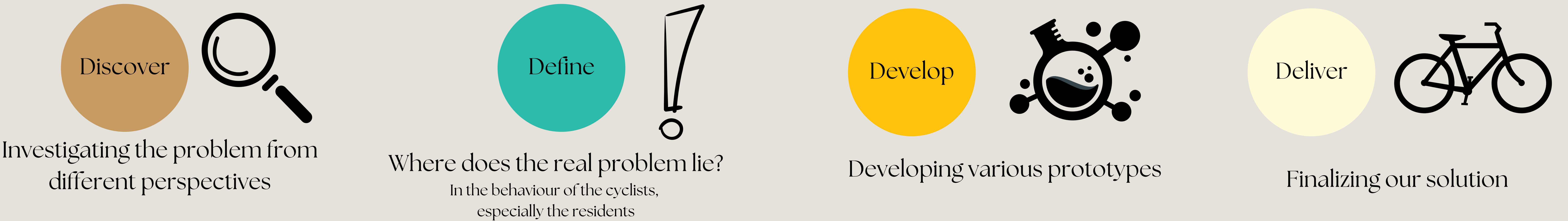

Due to the growing popularity of cycling tourism in Rennesse, combined with the redevelopment of the village center, there has been an increasing number of bicycles being parked in the area. During the busy summer months and weekends, the capacity is insufficient, and temporary "pop-up" parking locations are used. However, this has not fully solved the bicycle problem. People continue to park their bikes in areas that are not designated for parking. In some cases, this leads to dangerous situations where places and roads become inaccessible for emergency services. Additionally, members of the business associations are frustrated because bikes are being placed against their terraces.
